Here's the lowdown on the beer gardens: [Leinenkugel's](#) is in a glass pavilion with a retractable roof and serves more than 30 specialty drafts. [Joe Squared](#) serves coal-fired pizza so good that Zagat's named its bacon and clam pizza the best pie in Maryland. It also has a wide variety of risottos (and beer, of course).
